

Announcement of the Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering on the English Proficiency Requirement for Admission

According to the resolution of the committee meeting of the Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering No. 4/2022 on March 30, 2022, the resolution on the English Proficiency Requirement for Admission was stated as follows:

Item 1 Those interested in pursuing a doctoral program must present one of the following English proficiency test results from a Language Testing Centre to TGGS. The English proficiency test result must be no more than two years old from the test date and the score must meet the following criteria:

TOEFL (Paper Based)	not lower than	400-413	Points
TOEFL (ITP)	not lower than	400-413	Points
TOEFL (Computer Based)	not lower than	103	Points
TOEFL (Internet Based)	not lower than	32-34	Points
IELTS (Academic Module)	not lower than	4.5	Points
IELTS Indicator (Academic Module)	not lower than	4.5	Points
CU-TEP (120 Score)	not lower than	32-34	Points
K-STEP	not lower than	50%	

Item 2 Those interested in pursuing a master's program must present one of the following English proficiency test results from a Language Testing Centre to TGGS. The English proficiency test result cannot be more than two years old:

TOEFL (Paper Based), TOEFL (ITP), TOEFL (Computer Based), TOEFL (Internet Based) IELTS (Academic Module), IELTS Indicator (Academic Module) CU-TEP (120 Scores) K-STEP

Item 3 In the case of those interested in pursuing a master's program have an English proficiency test result from a Language Testing Centre other than those specified in the announcement, the applicant can submit a request to the committee of the Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering through the program coordinator or the curriculum chairman and TGGS Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Quality Management for consideration on a case by case basis in comparing and substituting the score from another Language Testing Centre to the Language Testing Centre specified in the announcement.

Item 4 In the case of those interested in pursuing a master's program do not have an English proficiency test result from the Language Testing Centre as specified in item 2, the applicant can submit supporting documents that demonstrating English language proficiency, such as a course certificate

of English language from a standardized institution, a good score in the English language course in the bachelor's or master's degree studies, degree certificate in English Program, International Program, or Program that teaches in English to the committee of the Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering through the program coordinator or the curriculum chairman and TGGS Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Quality Management for consideration on a case-by-case basis.

This announcement shall come into force as from the announced date.
