How to travel to TGGS	<p>The students are responsible for their own transportation from their home country to Bangkok Thailand and then from the airport to KMUTNB campus. The students can get to King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok by TAXI in the airport. The meter price is approximately 400 THB (included 110 THB expressway and airport fee 50 THB). It may take about 1-2 hours to get to the university (depended on the traffic).</p>
