

		<p><b>Note:</b> Applicants who are admitted without having submitted an English proficiency test score at the time of application, or whose submitted score does not meet the required minimum standard, will be required to enroll in and pass the courses “<b>Elementary English</b>” and “<b>Intermediate English,</b>” which will be provided by the Faculty later.</p>	
3	<b>Interview Process</b>	<p>3.1 The interview will be conducted in English, with each candidate allocated for 15 minutes.</p> <p>3.2 Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing portable devices, including mobile phones or translation aids, into the interview room. Such devices may be securely deposited with the designated examination room personnel.</p> <p>3.3 Candidates who are eligible to attend the interview are hereby requested to arrive at the designated interview venue no less than 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time. This is to ensure preparedness and to accommodate any potential modifications to the interview schedule.</p> <p>3.4 In the event that your name is called and you fail to present yourself at the specified time or do not attend the interview within the prescribed timeframe, the faculty reserves the exclusive right to consider denying your admission to the program for which you have applied.</p>	
4	<b>Required Attire</b>	<p>4.1 Candidates are required to wear their school uniform. In cases where wearing a school uniform is not possible, appropriate and formal attire suitable for the occasion is expected.</p> <p>4.2 Hairstyle and hair color requirements are not specified. Candidates are encouraged to exercise their judgment to ensure suitability and adherence to formal decorum.</p>	
5	<b>Presentation of Work, Free form (if applicable)</b>	<p>5.1 Portfolios are not subject to specific requirements regarding format or number of pages; however, they should be presented in their original, physical form.</p> <p>5.2 (If applicable) Actual workpieces may be presented. Any work or project brought for presentation must prioritize safety, appropriateness, and convenience during the presentation.</p> <p>5.3 There are no restrictions on the format of the work presentation. Examples include oral presentations, the use of supporting documents, certificates, letters of recommendation, photographs, or video demonstrations via the interviewer or electronic devices (e.g., Laptop/Tablet).</p> <p>5.4 Furthermore, for candidates required to present their work during the interview session, we kindly request that you bring your own electronic devices (e.g., Laptop/Tablet).</p>
