Admission to the Curriculum Master of Engineering in Electrical and Computer Engineering

1. Admission requirements

- Bachelor degree in engineering or science in relevant fields of Electrical and Computer Engineering
- Good English proficiency, please check the announcement by the academic affairs on the TGGS website https://tggs.kmutnb.ac.th/grad-admission-info
- Additional requirements for the Smart Grids Engineering track are as follows;
 - a) Applicant is recommended to have at least 2 years of work experience.
 - b) Applicant must submit a statement of purpose identifying the research topic of interest.
- Requirement for each study plan

Study plan 1.1

- Bachelor's degree GPA of at least 3.00 out of 4.00, or equivalent. If the GPA falls below 3.00, approval from the Electrical and Computer Engineering Program Committee is required.
- Have experience in internships, industrial work, research, or participating in projects related to the program. If such experience is not available, approval from the Electrical and Computer Engineering Program Committee is required.
- Have received consent to study through the chain of command from the department head or equivalent or higher, or the highest-ranking executive of the organization, if still an employee of the organization.

Study plan 1.2

- Bachelor's degree GPA of at least 2.75 out of 4.00, or equivalent. If the GPA falls below 2.75, approval from the Electrical and Computer Engineering Program Committee is required.

Study plan 2

- Bachelor's degree GPA of at least 2.75 out of 4.00, or equivalent. If the GPA falls below 2.75, approval from the Electrical and Computer Engineering Program Committee is required.
- Have work experience or be currently working, which can enhance work performance by integrating knowledge from the study. In the case that the requirement is not met, approval from the Electrical and Computer Engineering Program Committee is required.

2. Application documents

The fundamental applications documents are as follows,

- 1) Completion of the application form
- 2) Evidence of qualifications (certificates or transcripts)
- 3) Evidence of English Language Proficiency test
- 4) Two Letters of Recommendation in sealed envelopes
- 5) Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- 6) A copy of your identification card or passport
- 7) Financial statement (only for international students with self-support)

3. Admission process

There are two steps of selection. In the first step, the application will be assessed based on the submitted evidence by the recruitment committee, consisting of the ECE lecturers. In the second step, the selected applicants will be scheduled for a personal interview by the recruitment committee. For international students, the interview by phone or video call can be arranged.
