

3	Interview Process	<p>3.1 The interview will be conducted in English, with each candidate allocated for 15 minutes.</p> <p>3.2 Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing portable devices, including mobile phones or translation aids, into the interview room. Such devices may be securely deposited with the designated examination room personnel.</p> <p>3.3 Candidates who are eligible to attend the interview are hereby requested to arrive at the designated interview venue no less than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time. This is to ensure preparedness and to accommodate any potential modifications to the interview schedule.</p> <p>3.4 In the event that your name is called and you fail to present yourself at the specified time or do not attend the interview within the prescribed timeframe, the faculty reserves the exclusive right to consider denying your admission to the program for which you have applied.</p>
