## Dual Degree Program (TGGS – RWTH Aachen University, Germany)

TGGS offers a Dual Degree Program in collaboration with RWTH Aachen University for selected master's students in Electrical Power and Energy Engineering (EPE) and Communication and Smart System Engineering (CSE).

### ***Program Overview***

This program is available for final-year TGGS master's students. Selected students will have the opportunity to study at RWTH Aachen University in Germany for one additional semester, enhancing their international academic experience and exposure.

## Travel to TGGS

Students are responsible for arranging their own travel from their home country to Bangkok, Thailand, as well as transportation from the airport to KMUTNB.

- Taxi service is available at the airport
- Estimated cost: approximately 400 THB (including expressway and airport fees)
- Travel time: approximately 1–2 hours, depending on traffic conditions

## Estimated Living Expenses in Bangkok

Category	Estimated Cost
Accommodation	5,000 – 15,000 THB/month
Living expenses	9,000 – 12,000 THB/month
Health insurance	7,000 – 10,000 THB/year
Books & study materials	2,000 – 5,000 THB/semester
